Energy & Water Reporting & Benchmarking

Ontario's mandatory large building energy water reporting and benchmarking (EWRB) regulation (O. REG> 506/18) requires annual reporting of energy use, water use and greenhouse gas emissions to the Ontario Ministry of Energy, Northern Development and Mines for public disclosure.

This session outlined the requirements and obligations for building owners and their representatives under the regulation, highlighted the registration and reporting process, the ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager reporting platform, and disclosure outputs under the regulation.



Top takeaways:

- Mandatory energy reporting is required across North America and has helped building owners lower their energy use and save money.
- The Ministry of Energy supports reporting by providing information on its website
 - and provides one on one support through its call centre and email.
- It is important to understand how to use your utility billing data to benchmark against peers to make the business case for investment in conservation and find the biggest savings opportunities.
